- ❖ **Counseling** – guidance and psychotherapy for individuals of all ages and families
- ❖ **Case Management** – information and referral regarding a wide variety of mental health resources and social services in our community
- ❖ **Financial Resource Center** – grants and interest-free loans for Jewish families
- ❖ **Homemaker** – weekly home help and transportation for seniors
- ❖ **Lifeline** – electronic emergency response system
- ❖ **Bikur Chaverim** – “Visiting Friends,” a volunteer-based program providing home visits to homebound or partially homebound adults
- ❖ **Catch-a-Cab** – taxi coupons for older Jewish adults
- ❖ **Refugee Resettlement** – for older adult refugees from the former Soviet Union
- ❖ **Teen Suicide Prevention** - a school-based suicide awareness and prevention program called “Teen Life Counts”
- ❖ **Adoption** – adoption home studies
- ❖ **Holiday Services** – Passover Food Baskets, Rosh Hashanah Gift Bags, and Literacy & Latkes book drive for Chanukah
